Zozislaw Frank Misztal, CD 27 April 1946 – 20 June 2021



Frank Misztal was a member of the Canadian Association of Veterans in United Nations Peacekeeping and was a member of the National Headquarters Chapter, Ottawa, Ontario. He was also a member of the Ottawa Chapter and was the Secretary of that Chapter. Frank was appointed Web Master of the Association's Web Site on 19 October 2002 and remained as Web Master until April 2021.

Frank started his military career while in high school by joining the Royal Canadian Army Cadet Corps which was affiliated with the Queens Own Rifles of Canada. In November 1962 he became a member of 8th Signals Regiment, Royal Canadian Corps of Signals in Toronto.

In February 1989, Frank joined the Canadian Armed Forces and was affiliated with 1 Canadian Signal Regiments in Kingston, Ontario as a radio operator. He completed his first United Nations Tour with the United Nations Disengagement Observation Force Golan Heights (UNDOF) during the period March to September 1991. His second tour was with the United Nation Protection force Yugoslavia (UNPROFOR) during the period August 1994 to February 1995.

Frank retired after 40 years in uniform on 26 April 2002 and worked part-time as technical support for a local internet service provider in Kingston. He also helped service members by court mounting their deserved medals.
