William Albert “Al” Young, CD 23 July 1935 – 04 November 2021



Albert “Al” was a Member of the Canadian Association of Veterans in United Nations Peacekeeping and was a member of the William C. Hall, VC Greenwood Chapter, Greenwood, Nova Scotia.

Al joined The Canadian Army, Royal Canadian Corps of Signals as a radio operator and Lineman in October 1952. He earned his Parachute Wings with the Airborne Signals Squadron. He retired on completion of 36 years of service in August 1988.

He served two United Nations Mission with the United Nations Emergency Force (UNEF 1) during the period November 1965 to November 1966 as Message Center Superintendent and Radio and Telegraphy Operator, Ground to Air Communications with 56 Signals Squadron. His second tour was with United Nations Emergency Force (UNEF II) during the period August 1974 to February 1975 as Chief Communications Operator with Headquarters UNEF, Ismailia, Egypt as Chief Communications Adviser to UN Staff, as a Frequency Manager, Frequency Analysis, Communication Procedure and advise on overall VHF/HF Operations.

Al was a member of the Royal Canadian Legion Branch 26, Truro, Nova Scotia. He was also a member of the Signalers Club of Canada and the Atlantic Signals Association.
