### **Robert (Bob) Leo Barry, CD 25 May 1935 – 31 July 2020**



Robert Barry was a Member of the Canadian Association of Veterans in United Nations Peacekeeping and was a Member and Past President of the LGen R.R. Crabbe Chapter, Winnipeg, Manitoba.

Bob joined the Royal Canadian Corps of Signals in October 1953 where he became a Radio Operator. His first posting was to #1 Airborne Signals Squadron, Barriefield, Ontario. He completed his Parachute training at the Canadian Joint Air Training Center, Rivers, Manitoba in September 1954. He took his release in

October 1956.

Bob joined the Royal Canadian Air Force Reserve, 442 City of Vancouver Squadron, and was sent to Centralia Ontario for flying training. After training on various aircraft, he was presented his Royal Canadian Air Force Pilot's Wings in March 1959. He joined the Royal Canadian Air Force in October 1956 and served until his release in November 1966.

He completed a United Nations Tour with the United Nations Emergency Force (Middle East), with the 115 Air Traffic Unit, El Arish, Egypt during the period June 1963 – June 1964.

Bob was also a member of the Royal Canadian Legion Branch, Winnipeg, Manitoba, the Signaler's Club of Canada and the Royal Canadian Air Force Association. Also a member of the 283 Army, Navy and Air Force Branch, Winnipeg, Manitoba.
