Jarrott (Jerry) W. Holtzhauer, CD 31 August 1935 – 12 September 2020

Jarrott (Jerry) W. Holtzhauer was a member of the Canadian Association of Veterans in United Nations Peacekeeping and was a member of the Colonel John Gardam Chapter (Ottawa), Ontario. He was also the Central Region Director for the Association.

Jerry joined the Canadian Army in September 1955 and went on to graduate from Royal Military College, Victoria, BC and Royal Military College, Kingston, Ontario.

He completed a 35-year career serving with the Royal Canadian Army Service Corps as a Logistics Officer until his release in April 1990.

Jerry completed a United Nations tour with the United Nations Observation Group in India and Pakistan (UNMOGIP) during the period January 1970 to January 1971.

Jerry was also a member of the NATO Veterans Organization of Canada, Headquartered in Ottawa, Ontario. He was a member of the Royal Military Ex-Cadet Club and was involved in the development of the new Canadian War Museum, the “Passing of the Torch” campaign and served as President of the “Friends of the War Museum” for 12 years.

He was also, a dedicated volunteer for the Orleans-Cumberland Community Resource Centre.
